NEW BUSINESS

Recommendation for Award- 2017 Asphalt and Bituminous-Coated Aggregate

Dave Payne, Purchasing Manager, recommended approval of the Recommendation for Award of the Asphalt and Bituminous-Coated Aggregate to all bidders which include Asphalt Materials, Central Paving, Marathon Petroleum, Milestone Contractors and Rieth-Riley. It is in the best interest of both government agencies to seek the supplier with the lowest bid first and with consideration based on availability. Mrs. Murray moved for approval. Mr. Murtaugh seconded. Motion Carried.

Mr. Payne stated that the bid form for 2018 only had one area for delivery so Milestone Contractors submitted a bid for both a Tippecanoe County delivery price and a City of Lafayette delivery price. Mr. Payne stated that Milestone went ahead and withdrew their bid for the City of Lafayette price. Mr. Payne stated that Marathon Petroleum also withdrew their page from the bid.
