City of Lafayette Awards Small Businesses with CDBG Funds

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – June 10, 2020 – The City of Lafayette is pleased to announce that two (2) additional small businesses were awarded \$9,176 in special Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) that were impacted by COVID-19. This brings the total to 42 small businesses that have received the CDBG funds to date.

Locally owned small businesses with 25 or fewer employees, located in the Lafayette Entrepreneur and Enterprise District (the former Urban Enterprise Zone) and/or certain designated low and moderate-income census tracts were eligible to apply for assistance up to \$10,000 for rent/mortgage, employee payroll, and/or utility expenses.

“I’m so pleased that the City can continue its support of small businesses impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic”, states Mayor Tony Roswarski. “Supporting local businesses throughout Greater Lafayette will have an impact on the recovery of our local economy. So as you shop locally, please continue the health and safety measures set forth to protect you and those around you.”
