Lafayette City Council Moves Forward with Financing for Construction of New Public Safety Building and Parking Garage

Public Community Meeting to discuss the project set for November 19.

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – November 2, 2020 – At the November 2 Lafayette City Council meeting, the Council approved an ordinance for the financing and construction of a new Public Safety Building and Public Parking Garage on the south side of Columbia Street between 6th and 7th Streets.

The ordinance approved a lease between the City of Lafayette Redevelopment Commission and the City of Lafayette Redevelopment Authority to issue its Lease Rental Revenue Bonds in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount not to exceed forty-five million dollars (\$45,000,000). The amount will be to finance the costs of the planning, designing and construction of the new multi-story municipal public safety building of approximately 65,000 square feet with a new parking garage of 500-600 spaces.

The City of Lafayette invites you to attend a Public Community Meeting to discuss the future vision of the new Public Safety Building and Garage on Thursday, November 19, 7 pm, at the Long Center of the Performing Arts, 111 N. 6th Street, Lafayette, IN. Masks will be required with social distancing protocols to be in place as well as capacity restrictions. There will also be a virtual Zoom meeting if you cannot attend in person.
