Mayor Roswarski Tests Positive for COVID-19

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – November 18, 2020 – City Clerk Cindy Murray is announcing this morning that Mayor Tony Roswarski has tested positive for the coronavirus. After a confirmed positive test result yesterday afternoon around 5 pm, Mayor Roswarski is resting at home and will self-quarantine for the next two weeks. Those that have been in close contact with the Mayor have been notified to take the necessary precautions.

“The business of the City will continue as usual and we wish the Mayor a quick and full recovery,” states Murray. “I know that Mayor Roswarski will take the necessary steps in following the advice of his health care professionals during his recuperation.”

Mayor Roswarski has emphasized the importance of following CDC and the Tippecanoe County Health Department guidelines for wearing a facemask in public, sanitizing your hands, and following social distancing protocols. He continues to stress these recommendations in order not to contract this virus.
