Public Safety Building and Parking Garage Meeting Rescheduled

Public Community Meeting will be held online December 16

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – December 2, 2020 – After the necessary postponement of a public meeting due to illness and concerns surrounding large gatherings, the City of Lafayette has set a date and time for a virtual meeting. You are invited to virtually attend a Public Community Meeting to discuss the future vision of the new Public Safety Building and Garage on **Wednesday, December 16, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.** The meeting will be held via Zoom, details of which can be found on the City's Facebook calendar (@LafayetteIN) or website (Lafayette.in.gov).

At the November 2 Lafayette City Council meeting, the Council approved an ordinance for the financing and construction of a new Public Safety Building and Public Parking Garage on the south side of Columbia Street between 6th and 7th Streets. The ordinance approved a lease between the City of Lafayette Redevelopment Commission and the City of Lafayette Redevelopment Authority to issue its Lease Rental Revenue Bonds in one or more series. The bonds will be to finance the costs of the planning, designing and construction of the new multi-story municipal public safety building of approximately 65,000 square feet with a new parking garage of 500-600 spaces.

Public participation is encouraged at this meeting via the Zoom meeting. The meeting will also be streamed live through Facebook and YouTube (@CityofLafayetteIN) for those who wish to view without interacting. A dedicated webpage will be shared during the presentation.
