City of Lafayette to Hold Public Meeting for 3rd/4th Street Conversion Project

City of Lafayette to update and inform the public about the implementation and construction for the conversion of 3rd and 4th Street for two-way traffic.

LAFAYETTE, INDIANA – September 20, 2023 – The City Engineer’s Office and the Economic Development Department are holding a public meeting to update and inform property owners, businesses, and the public about the 3rd & 4th Streets Conversion Feasibility Study dated December 8, 2020. The project is to convert 3rd St. and 4th St. to allow for two-way traffic along both streets. The conversion will take place along the existing one-way streets between Alabama St. and Wall St. The city intends to take a complete streets approach during this conversion and include bicycle lanes in both directions along 4th Street, as well as “bicycles share the road” markings on 3rd Street. The southbound bicycle lane on 4th Street will require the removal of some on-street parking along portions of the west side of the street. On-street parking on the east side of 4th Street will remain. The installation of bicycle lanes is consistent with the Lafayette Bike and Pedestrian Plan, as well as the Greater Lafayette Climate Action Plan. On-street parking on both sides of 3rd Street will remain the same.
