***** PARKING OPERATIONS UPDATE *****
2 & 3 HOUR PARKING ZONE ENFORCEMENT BEGINS JUNE 15

As a result of Indiana's Stay-At-Home order issued by Governor Eric Holcomb, the City of Lafayette began implementing numerous changes to how the many different city departments would operate during this pandemic.

One of those operational changes had to do with parking enforcement in downtown Lafayette. In an effort to help those now sheltering-in-place or working remotely from home, the City of Lafayette temporarily suspended enforcement of the time restricted parking limits for on-street 2 and 3 hour parking zones.

There were many essential businesses that remained open and commercial deliveries were still being made daily throughout the downtown area. As a result, Parking Operations continued to monitor and enforce all other parking ordinances including, but not limited to, handicap zones, space markings, loading zones, and fire hydrant zones as examples.

At this time, we will restart enforcement efforts of the 2 and 3 hour parking zones beginning June 15, 2020. This will coincide better with the State's *Back on Track Indiana* Stage 4 plan.
